Seven things you can do

Shop local: We are within walking distance to the beautiful village of Ribchester and Stydd Gardens, where you will find an array of independent businesses selling local produce for you to buy and enjoy.

Conserve energy: Remember to switch off lights when leaving a room and turning off any appliances not in use. If you're cold, close any windows whilst the heating is on, and light the fire.

Give the car a rest: Even if only for one day; walk, cycle, or use public transport. We have some great walks on our doorstep and buses run hourly to local towns.
